

Finalist Agreement – Miss Environment Netherlands 2026

Between:

1. **Time To Shine Pageants**, part of **TVM Allround**, located at Monsterstraat 4 E, Oss, registered with the Chamber of Commerce under number **91234891**, hereinafter referred to as the “**Organizer**”,
and
2. _____ (name), born on -- _____ (date of birth), residing at _____ (address),
hereinafter referred to as the “**Finalist**”,

the following has been agreed:

Article 1 – Purpose of the Agreement

The Finalist agrees to participate in the national beauty pageant **Miss Environment Netherlands 2026**, organized by the Organizer, taking place between **October 2025 and January 2026**, subject to changes in the schedule and program duration. Any such changes will be communicated in writing.

Article 2 – Participation Requirements

1. The Finalist declares that she:
 - Is at least **18 years old** (or **minimum 15 with parental/guardian consent**) at the time of registration;
 - Is **not married** and does **not have children** (unless otherwise agreed with the Organizer);
 - Has **no criminal record**;
 - Has **no contractual obligations** that conflict with participation in this competition;
 - Has **no sexually explicit or nude images** of herself online;
 - Is available for **all mandatory activities and preparations** as determined by the Organizer.

Article 3 – Obligations of the Finalist

1. The Finalist agrees to:
 - Participate in **all rehearsals, photoshoots, media appearances, and official events**;
 - Pay the **entry fee of €275** (in words: two hundred seventy-five euros) on the **first day of the program, October 5th**;
 - Purchase a **minimum of 10 tickets** at €35 each (in words: thirty-five euros),

totaling **€350**, to be paid by **November 9th, 2025**;

- Tickets may be exchanged between finalists; the group must collectively meet the required minimum of 10 tickets;
 - After the first introduction day on **October 5, 2025**, withdrawal from the contract is no longer possible, and **all obligations and payments remain binding**;
 - Maintain a **respectful and professional attitude** toward other participants, jury members, and the organization;
 - **Promote the pageant** on social media (if requested);
 - Comply with all **rules, instructions, and the code of conduct** as set by the Organizer (see code of conduct attachment).

Article 4 – Obligations of the Organizer

The Organizer commits to:

- Providing a **safe and fair competition environment**;
 - Sharing **timely information** regarding events, rehearsals, and obligations;
 - Making available any **prizes** as described in the competition regulations.

Article 5 – Image Rights

1. The Organizer reserves the right to use **photos, videos, and other recordings** of the Finalist taken during the program for **promotional purposes**, without additional compensation.
 2. The Finalist grants permission for the use of her image as described above.

Article 6 – Confidentiality

The Finalist agrees not to disclose any **confidential information** regarding the organization or other participants without prior written consent.

Article 7 – Disqualification

The Organizer reserves the right to disqualify the Finalist in case of:

- Violation of the rules;
 - Unprofessional behavior;
 - Failure to make payments on time;
 - Providing false or incomplete information during registration.

Article 8 – Liability

The Organizer is not liable for:

- **Personal injury or property loss;**
 - **Any expenses incurred by the Finalist** outside the pre-agreed reimbursements.

Article 9 – Duration and Termination

This agreement becomes effective on the date of signing and remains in effect until the **end date of the pageant program: January 11, 2026**, unless terminated earlier under **Article 7**.

If the Finalist wins a **subtitle**, the contract remains valid until the title is passed on, as described in the **Code of Conduct**.

If the Finalist wins the pageant, a **new contract** will be issued.

Article 10 – Applicable Law

This contract is governed by **Dutch law**. Any disputes will be submitted to the **competent court in Oss, the Netherlands**.
